### Where to find us:

#### From Swansea, Neath or Resolven direction or from Aberdare direction

Follow the A465 to Glynneath., take the A4109 to Onllwyn, go straight through the traffic lights at Glynneath and follow the road until you come to a crossroads, which is signposted d.o.v.e. Workshop.

Turn left into Dyffryn Cellwen. Carry on straight through Roman Road and take the second turning on the left between the row of terraced houses.

d.o.v.e. Workshop is the single storey building immediately in front of you.

#### From Ammanford Direction

Take the A4068 from Brynamman, then the A4067 to Abercrave.

Turn right for the A4221 to Dyffryn Cellwen. Turn right at the second crossroads into Dyffryn Cellwen, which is signposted to d.o.v.e. Workshop. Carry on straight through Roman Road and take the second turning on the left between the row of terraced houses.

d.o.v.e. Workshop is the single storey building immediately in front of you.

Maintenance grants of up to £4,500 are now available. The money you receive isn't a loan – you won't need to pay it back.

The amount you receive is based on your annual household income, and how many credits you are planning to study during the year. For example, if your household income is £25,000 or below and you plan to study 90 credits or more during the year you could receive £4,500.
